

PROCEDURE FOR DG EXEMPTION AND MATERIAL SAFETY DATA SHEET (MSDS) VERIFICATION

Please follow the below checkpoints before submitting the MSDS and related documents for verification:

1. A 'Non-Dangerous Commodity (Exempted) Declaration' should be submitted together with the MSDS

2. The MSDS must be in PDF format with either manufacturer or booking party's company chop is required on MSDS and issued within 5 years
3. Test Report (if required as per IMDG code) must be in PDF format certified by Laboratory
4. Test certificate should be issued by China National Accreditation Service. For Recognized Test Center, please visit via below link:

5. The MSDS must include "Product Name", "Transport Information" and "Composition / Information on Ingredients" sections
6. The MSDS should clearly declare whether the commodity is regulated by IMDG Code or not
7. Section numbers in the MSDS should be in sequential order
8. Non-Dangerous Commodity (Exempted) Declaration which is required for each and every shipment. Please submit together with your booking request
9. Please note that it is shipper's responsibility to identify and declare his cargo as DG or non DG
