

## ONE EA's First CSR Activity: Mudflat & Beach Clean Up

- Horseshoe Crab Habitat Restoration -

**22 November 2018 – Hong Kong** – Ocean Network Express (East Asia) Ltd. ("ONE EA"), in collaboration with the Ocean Park Conservative Foundation Hong Kong, held its first corporate social responsibility ("CSR") activity to clean the mudflats and beach of Shui Hau Wan, Lantau Island of Hong Kong for the restoration of feeding ground for horseshoe crabs on 17 November 2018.

Horseshoe crabs are considered "living fossils" as they are creatures living on the earth for more than two hundred million years, and the extract of their blood (blue in colour) is widely used to make bacterial detectors for medical products testing. Their well-being therefore gives significant evolutionary and biological value to human beings. Horseshoe crabs' natural habitat is mudflats, which unfortunately, have been degraded due to urban development and pollution that would risk the species' extinction.

In this meaningful CSR activity to clean the mudflats and beach for restoring a clean habitat especially for juvenile horseshoe crabs, a group of more than forty keen ONE EA staff and their family members have participated. In the process, ONE EA members not only put into action to collect more than one hundred kilograms of garbage of all sorts in the area, the awareness and commitment in environmental preservation was further reinforced among ourselves.
